



Georgetown Sertoma Club is SHARP!

The members of the **Georgetown Sertoma Club** are very involved in SHARP (Sertoma Hearing Aid Recycling Program). The Club maintains eight collection centers for used hearing aids with six locations in Georgetown, one in Temple and one in Killeen. Together, the centers collect 25-40 hearing aids each quarter that are recycled and stocked at a hearing aid bank at the University of Texas Speech and Hearing Center for central Texas residents in need of hearing assistance.

In June, the Club partnered with Estes Audiology to conduct a hearing aid drive. This effort was coordinated by Estes and the Georgetown Sertoma Club and Windcrest Sertoma Club in San Antonio. The Georgetown event was held at Dell Webb's Sun City where hot dogs and ice cream were served up, along with music and chances to purchase a duck for the July 4th duck race sponsored by the Round Rock Sertoma Club. At the conclusion of the event, Jim Wilson of the Georgetown Club presented Ann Hillis of the University of Texas Speech and Hearing Center 40 over the ear aids and 154 inner ear aids, for a total of 203 hearing aids with an estimated value close to \$92,000.
